

Thank you for your recent purchase of GEE Whiz 2.0. In the email containing this document, you will find a zip file that contains the full purchase licence files for your server. You will need to replace the existing trial licence files with the new full purchase licence files.

Please follow the instructions carefully:

1. Close any browser windows that are accessing the GEE Whiz Admin web console.
2. Unload GEE2 and GEE2WEB
 - a. (NetWare) press "**F7**" from both GEE2 and GEE2WEB server console and ensure that the protected address space has been removed (check Monitor > Virtual Memory > Address Space). If either the GEE2 or GEE2WEB address space is still running, then you must kill the address space by typing:
 - i. **unload kill address space = gee2web** (for the GEE2 Web Server) or
 - ii. **unload kill address space = gee2** (for GEE Whiz 2)
 - b. (Linux) type **killall -15 gee2** and **killall -15 gee2web** at a console prompt or terminal window
3. Rename the existing **public.pem** and **private.pem** license files to **public.pem.old** and **private.pem.old** located in the following directories:
 - a. (NetWare) SYS:\GEE2\ and SYS:\GEE2WEB\
 - b. (Linux) /opt/gee2/ and /opt/gee2web/
4. Copy the respective licence files from the .zip file you received to the corresponding correct locations:
 - a. (NetWare) copy:
 - i. gee2\public.pem and gee2\private.pem files to SYS:\GEE2\
 - ii. gee2web\public.pem and gee2web\private.pem files to SYS:\GEE2WEB\
 - b. (Linux) copy:
 - i. gee2\public.pem and gee2\private.pem files to /opt/gee2/
 - ii. gee2web\public.pem and gee2web\private.pem files to /opt/gee2web/
 5. Load GEE2 and GEE2WEB:
 - a. (NetWare) type **GEE2 <enter>** and **GEE2WEB <enter>** at a server console, or
 - b. (Linux) at a server console or terminal screen:
 - i. **cd /opt/gee2** and type **./gee2**
 - ii. **cd /opt/gee2web/** and type **./gee2web**
 6. Open a browser and access the GEE Whiz Admin web console.
